

 Construction work proceeds at the site during the current COVID-19 prevention guideline directives from the State's Governor. Sundt is following recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) on social distancing and hygiene practices for all its employees and subcontractors. Daily temperature checks have been implemented for all employees on site.

New Science, Engineering, and Mathematics Building

- Furniture delivery and installation are underway at the project. Items delivered are being coordinated for assembly and location by Dovetail Solutions. Activities are anticipated to conclude in mid-July with the moving of building users to the new structure.
- Commissioning is nearing completion at the building. Exterior Lighting is 90% complete; however, landscape lighting up-wash lights were not functional at the time of testing. Pending testing is landscape irrigation as the controller is going to be replaced to match what is currently installed throughout Campus. A final test should be conducted after the controller is swapped. Plumbing rechecks are 50% complete.

Fine Arts Building Renovation

- Following the completion of the 50% Construction Documents phase of design, the Campus Project Team and Construction Manager proceeded with the review of the completed drawings and specifications. Cost estimates were generated and reconciled in early June, which have resulted in an ongoing cost-reduction effort to align with the established project budget.
- DSA approved in mid-June the submitted

Evaluation Design Criteria Report (EDCR) submitted by the design team in April. This approval clears the way for the submittal of the project for review and approval once the Construction Documents Phase is completed in October 2021.

- In late June, the Campus Project Team released a Request for Proposals for material testing and inspection services from the District's pool based on the required destructive testing per the approved EDCR.
- The hazardous materials testing and report development is ongoing and is anticipated to be completed in Q3-2021.
- The building user group met with Dovetail, the project's furniture, fixtures, and equipment (FF&E) consultant for the determination of the needs for the project per programming and standards. Additional meetings will be held in July and August to finalize furniture selection.

• The schematic design phase for this project was completed on June 11th with the submittal of drawings and specifications by the design team. The Campus Project Team is leading a review of the submitted package and will conduct a cost-reduction effort to align the scope with the project budget.



Greenhouse Replacement

 There are no updates during this reporting period.

New Instructional Building

• The East and West fire lanes have been closed to allow for soil compaction, installation of reinforcement bars, and the framing of concrete falsework for hardscape features and retaining walls. The initial concrete pours for the paths of travel and fire lanes on the perimeter of the building started on the second week of June and will continue through the end of the month. Pavers will be installed upon completion of all site work installation; the south portal entrance installation started in late June.



Greenhouse Replacement Construction Progress - May 2021

Underground irrigation lines were installed around the building and landscaping is being placed as concrete pours are done.

- The dome water barrier has been placed. The tile design placement started the first week of June and was completed by the end of the month. Scaffolding is anticipated to be dismantled at the beginning of July. Plaster placement started on the remaining areas of the exterior structure on the second week of June and is anticipated to be completed in early July. Work on the courtyard is nearing completion with all landscaping installed and tile work on the feature fountain is anticipated to be done by the middle of July.
- On the inside of the building, work is nearing completion on finishes at all levels. Programming on

audio/visual equipment continues at all three levels of the building. Work in stairwells has been completed and feature lighting was installed on the second week of June. At the lobby the medallion with the Campus logo is nearing completion. This activity is proceeding alongside all tile work placement at this location, the main stairwell, and the central courtyard. Air circulation throughout the building started in late June and has continued in July for the flushing of any components resulting from the placement of building finishes. Commissioning startup reports were issued in July, and efforts to start testing are expected to commence in

August. Training for the use of equipment is scheduled to take place in July.

Changes to the approved construction documents were made by means of Construction Change
Documents or CCD. Changes affecting the Structural, Access or Fire & Life Safety portions of the
project must be submitted to DSA for review and approval. The following is a brief tally of the CCDs

- Testing and Balancing (TAB) started at the building. Preparations in anticipation for commissioning functional testing started in June and continued through early July. Pipe labeling and insulation installation concluded in late June into early July. Commissioning testing is anticipated for the second week of July. Fire alarm testing was underway in late June and was successfully completed in early July. A punch-list walk was conducted with the architect of record and engineers in early June, followed by a similar walk with Campus Facilities Representatives in late June.
- Changes to the approved construction documents were made by means of Construction Change Documents or CCD. Changes affecting the Structural, Access or Fire & Life Safety portions of the project must be submitted to DSA for review and approval. Renovate Buildings 300 & 500

• Meetings took place in late June to evaluate strategies for the re-bidding of the renovation scope of work to interested general contractors. Part of this effort included a session with the San Diego office of DSA. From this meeting, the design and project teams obtained valuable details on allowable changes to the scope of work like seismic rehabilitation to the buildings. Similarly,

the District met with the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (CCCCO) to review potential scenarios and their impact on funding availability from the State.

Rodriguez Engineering is simultaneously conducting an analysis of potential seismic upgrades. This
study and a proposed timeline/schedule is to be submitted to the CCCCO for consideration in the
steps ahead for the project. The College and District teams anticipate reaching a final decision in the
early weeks of the third quarter of 2021.

New Maintenance & Operations Building

Four companies submitted responses to the RFP/Q for the design and construction of this building in
conjunction with the Chapman/Newell Instructional Building. One firm was disqualified and the other
three were invited for interviews with the selection committee in late June. Upon completion of the
final evaluation process a selection was made, which in turn, will be presented to the Board of
Trustees in late July.

Chapman / Newell Instructional Building

 Four companies submitted responses to the RFP/Q for the design and construction of this building in conjunction with the Maintenance and Operations facility. One firm was disqualified and the other three were invited for interviews with the selection committee in late June. Upon completion of the final evaluation process a selection was made, which in turn will be presented to the Board of Trustees in late July.

New Performing Arts Complex

- The schematic design phase concluded in early June with the sign-off by the building user group on the initial design lay-outs for the new complex. The design development of the building will proceed in the upcoming months in tandem with easement studies and requirements for the Southern California Edison transformers and utility meters in the vicinity of the project.
- The design and Campus project teams have concluded the preliminary drawing phase of design.
 Drawings and specifications were submitted to the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office
 (CCCCO) on June 30th for their review and approval of additional funding for the working drawings
 phase of design. The revised design includes changes to restroom and lobby sizes, as well as improved
 building efficiency in line with JCAF-32 programming requirements.





The RFP is anticipated to be released in late July, upon approval of funds from the State's Department of Finance and the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (CCCCO). Planning and scope verification are expected to start by the middle of the third quarter of 2021.


