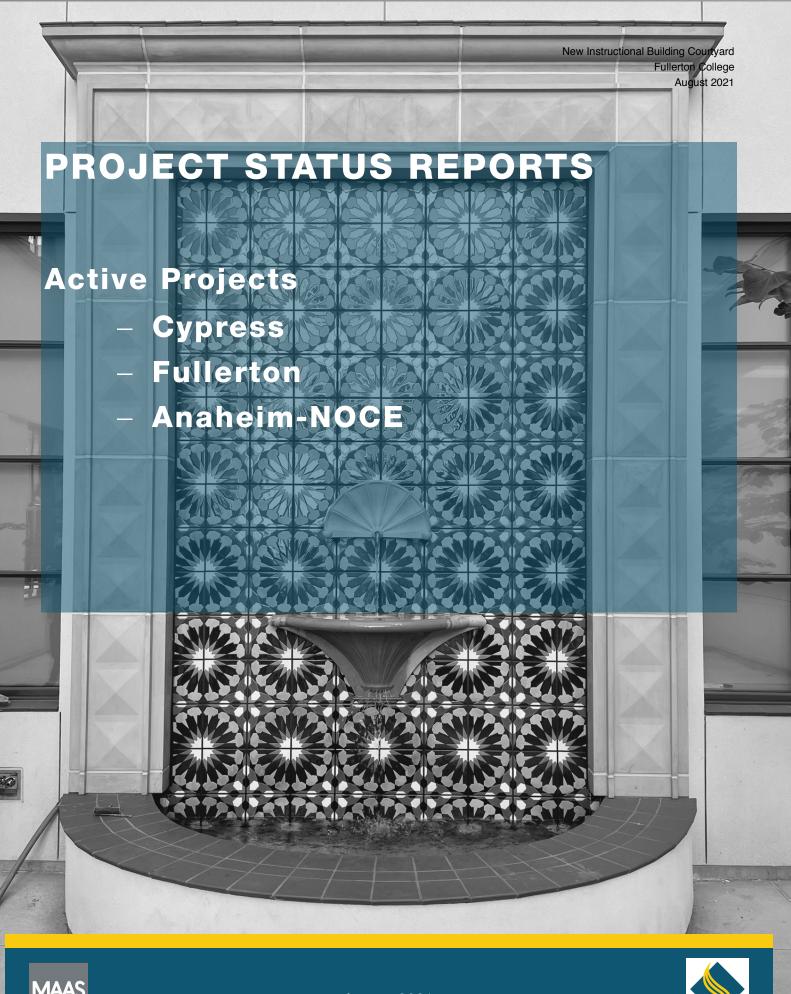

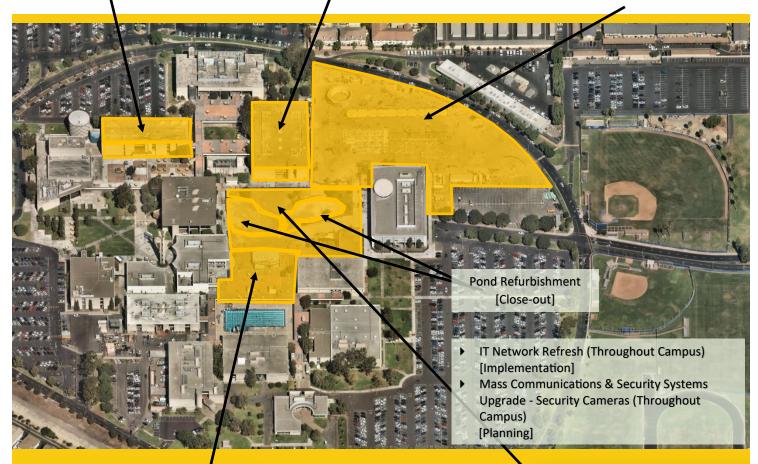

Campus

 Construction work proceeds at the site during the current COVID-19 prevention guideline directives from the State's Governor. Sundt is following recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) on social distancing and hygiene practices for all its employees and subcontractors. Daily temperature checks have been implemented for all employees on site.

New Science, Engineering, and Mathematics Building

Substantial completion was achieved on June 7th, 2021 marking the conclusion of all major construction activities at the building and surrounding site. Work continues addressing outstanding punch-list items throughout the building. Glass panels were installed for the greenhouse enclosure on the second floor of the building. Testing and balancing assessments have been completed and are under review by the Architect of Record and the project's mechanical engineering team. The project's final completion date of July 19th was not fully achieved. The Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR), Sundt Construction, intends to extend punch-list activities as well as the gathering of close-out documentation

into August. Final furniture deliveries are also anticipated to arrive in early August. The Campus Project Team is holding meetings with the CMAR for a tentative revision of the project's completion date to August 19th, 2021.

- Following the completion of the 50% Construction Documents phase of design, the Campus Project Team and Construction Manager proceeded with the review of the completed drawings and specifications. Cost estimates were generated and reconciled in early June. Efforts are ongoing to reduce the project costs, where possible, to more closely align with the established construction budget.
- DSA approved in mid-June the submitted Evaluation Design Criteria Report (EDCR) provided by the design team in April. Ninyo & Moore was the selected consultant for the materials testing, inspection services, and deconstructive testing. Efforts in deconstructive testing are beginning mid-August.
- The hazardous materials testing concluded in July. The final report was received on July 19th. The
 project design team is developing specifications to be included in the project in relation to the report's
 results.

• The development of construction documents for this project has reached the 70% completion milestone. Reviews by the Campus Project Team are underway. The Team is also conducting an ongoing cost-reduction effort to align the scope of work with the established construction budget.

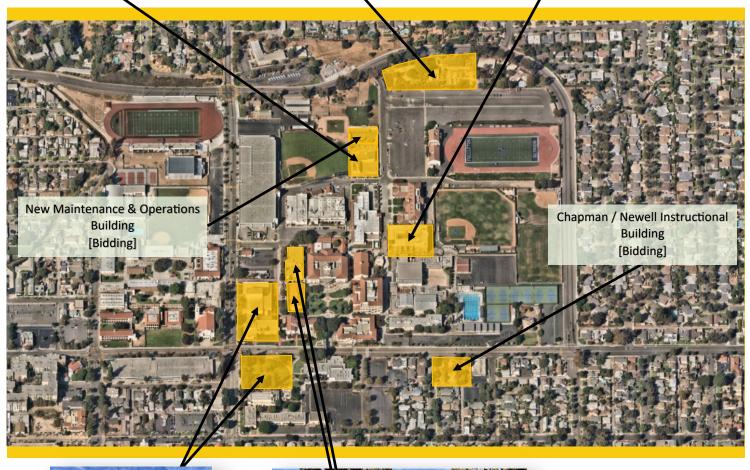

Project Overview

Total renovation of Buildings 300 and 500, including historic consideration of Building 300. The renovated buildings will contain general classrooms, Computer Information Systems (CIS) laboratories, Academic Computing Technologies (ACT) laboratories, photography laboratories, dean and faculty offices, shared laboratories, and a lecture hall. The District and the Campus Project Team are assessing changes in the scope of the project, including the potential deferral of renovations at Building 500, based on continuing seismic evaluations for both buildings. Results of the assessment are anticipated in late September 2021. Changes in scope can jeopardize the availability of matching State funds for the project. Project Overview

This project addresses the demand for enrollments in the performing arts programs by constructing a new complex bringing music, drama, theater arts, and communication programs together into a single facility. The new building replaces outdated facilities with electrical deficiencies and outmoded configurations. The new structure will take advantage of the potential use of commonly required spaces to improve overall utilization and flexible spaces that help programs in meeting higher demands anticipated in the near future. At the current stage of design, early estimates suggest the need for budgetary revisions in the order of \$40-\$50 million to match project programming and equipment requirements. As this project is integral to the Campus master plan and changes in scope can jeopardize the availability of matching State funds for the project, assessments are underway for the increase of Measure J funding. Transfers of funds will be completed from lower-priority projects at the Campus. District Staff will be leading a project update presentation to the Board of Trustees at the second meeting in September 2021. Refer to Updates on Campus Project pages ahead for more details.

UPDATES ON CAMPUS PROJECTS - FULLERTON COLLEGE

Campus

• Construction work at active project sites proceeds during the current COVID-19 protection guideline directives from the State's Governor. BN Builders is following revised recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) on hygiene practices for all its employees and subcontractors. As mitigation measures to prevent COVID-19 outbreaks, temperature checks are being performed before personnel are walking on-site and stretch and flex. Work is being segmented in areas where personnel are asked to remain during a day's work to complete their tasks. Visitors are provided a wristband as a visible check that they have provided contact details before accessing the site or meetings related to the project.

Greenhouse Replacement

 There are no updates during this reporting period.

New Instructional Building

 All scaffolding around the building's exterior has been dismantled as work has successfully concluded along the upper elevations of the building facade. The remaining exterior work in the building is focused on the west and north portals. The tile installation at the west portal is completed and will proceed on the remaining two entry points by the end of the month.



Greenhouse Replacement Construction Progress — May 2021

- Site work is nearing completion with the north and west fire lane concrete pours completed. The final concrete pour was done on July 23rd. The fire sprinkler system and the fire alarm testing started in mid-July and is anticipated to end in early August. Exterior security monitoring cameras have been installed and will be programmed in early August. Paver installation followed around the building with anticipated completion in early August. Safety railing for exterior ramps is anticipated to be installed in August.
- The placement of tile in the courtyard continued in early July alongside and all exterior window sills on the first and second floors. Door hardware installation was also completed in mid-July at all exterior and courtyard doors.





UPDATES ON CAMPUS PROJECTS - FULLERTON COLLEGE (Continued)



New Instructional Construction Progress —July 2021

- The preparations for the closing of Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) permits are underway. A punchlist walk took place in late July to note items that need to be addressed before the closing of these permits upon project completion in September. Landscape irrigation & drip watering systems are in progress with a target completion on the second week of August.
- The final cleaning of hallways at the buildings' second and third floors was completed in mid-July. Crews moved into the individual classrooms, offices, and other support spaces to complete

cleaning activities. At the building stairwells, the remaining railing components are anticipated to be installed in early August. Computer furniture is anticipated to be delivered to the site starting on August 20. The installation will take place in the last week of August and into early September. All other furniture will be delivered to the building in early September with installation to proceed soon thereafter. Dovetail Consultants is coordinating the deliveries, assembly, and installation of furniture to the building. Shipments are anticipated to start in the second week of August.

- The project close-out activities are proceeding. The electrical systems at all floors were inspected and tested in July in preparation for the final punch-list walks. Punch walks were conducted on June 21st with the project's AOR, Campus Facilities, and the General Contractor. Training of Campus Facilities personnel was scheduled for late July. A final walk with subcontractors and manufacturers for roof installation was conducted on July 7th. A final report noting any installation comments is forthcoming. The electronic documentation such as manuals, as-builts, among others, is being reviewed and approved by the AOR and will be provided for uploading to PROMPT. Attic stock materials were handed over to Campus Facilities in early July.
- Testing and Balancing (TAB) activities are underway for the building's chilled water supply to the HVAC equipment. In August air flows will be tested and adjusted throughout the building. Training for Campus Facilities personnel was completed on July 26th, 2021. Videos of the sessions and all other pertinent information will be turned over to the District and Campus as part of the close-out documents for the project.





UPDATES ON CAMPUS PROJECTS - FULLERTON COLLEGE (Continued)

- Substantial completion for the building is anticipated to be achieved on September 17th. The
 procurement of ADA-accessible mechanisms for window openings has a 9 to 12-week lead time upon
 placement of the order. Final completion is potentially impacted as it cannot be achieved until this
 item is fully installed at one window in each room. The Campus project team is working on strategies
 to mitigate impacts to the project's schedule as a result of this accessibility requirement.
- The move-in date for building users is tracking during October 2021. Preparations are also underway for opening ceremonies to take place that month.

Central Plant Replacement & Expansion

Functional testing is anticipated to take place in late July. Commissioning activities will be continuing into August. The project close-out is progressing at a steady pace. Training has been completed for Campus Facilities personnel. All electronic documentation is being reviewed and approved by the project's AOR and commissioning agent. Once approved, it will be submitted for uploading to PROMPT. The attic stock materials were handed over to Campus Facilities in July. The fine-tuning of equipment in preparation for functional was underway in late testing Adjustments to the sequence of functions

also took place to match the operational requirements from Campus Facilities. Functional testing is expected to take place with Enovity, the building's commissioning agent, from late July to early August. Substantial completion is expected to be achieved on August 13th, 2021. DSA documentation is being gathered for the completion of the 6-series forms which mark the completion of all construction work in accordance with approved documents.

Renovate Buildings 300 & 500

 The ASCE-Tier 1 seismic evaluation for Building 300 continues this month. The final report is anticipated to be complete by late August for review by the Campus Project Team. The results will also be shared with DSA and CCCCO for the evaluation of the inclusion of voluntary seismic rehabilitation tasks in the project's scope of work.

New Maintenance & Operations Building

 An addendum was issued for the Request for Proposals (RFP) related to commissioning services for the building. Responses from interested vendors part of the District's pre-qualified list of commissioning agents was due in late July.

Chapman / Newell Instructional Building

 An addendum was issued for the Request for Proposals (RFP) related to commissioning services for the building. Responses from interested vendors part of the District's pre-qualified list of commissioning agents was due in late July.

New Performing Arts Complex

- Design development continued in July with a meeting on the 23rd between the Campus project team and design team to discuss building facade parameters and interior space components. Weekly meetings are anticipated to be reinstated in August upon approval of additional funding for the second half of the design phase by the CCCCO and the State's Department of Finance. A preliminary meeting with DSA for the review of the building's design in preparation for the Construction Documents Submittal is anticipated to take place in late August. The Design Development phase final deliverable is scheduled to be delivered on September 1st, 2021.
- The Campus project team continues working in collaboration with Southern California Edison (SCE) for
 the relocation of an existing transformer and underground electrical duct bank currently located
 within the footprint of the future building. An application for the scope of work was submitted to the
 local utility company and will be proceeded by a separate design and process spearheaded by SCE in
 coordination with the project's design team. Planning is in progress for the construction activities
 related to this relocation.
- Pfeiffer, the project's Architect of Record (AOR), completed initial studies on potential building
 facades and elevations. The results were presented to the building user group in late July for review
 and feedback. In July, the design team also completed an update to the construction cost estimate
 after the first major stage of design, 100% schematic design. The Campus Project Team will be
 conducting sessions to review the presented costs and prepare pathways for the potential adjustment
 of scope or budgets based on the findings.
- An addendum was issued for the Request for Proposals (RFP) related to commissioning services for the building. Responses from interested vendors part of the District's pre-qualified list of commissioning agents are due in early August.

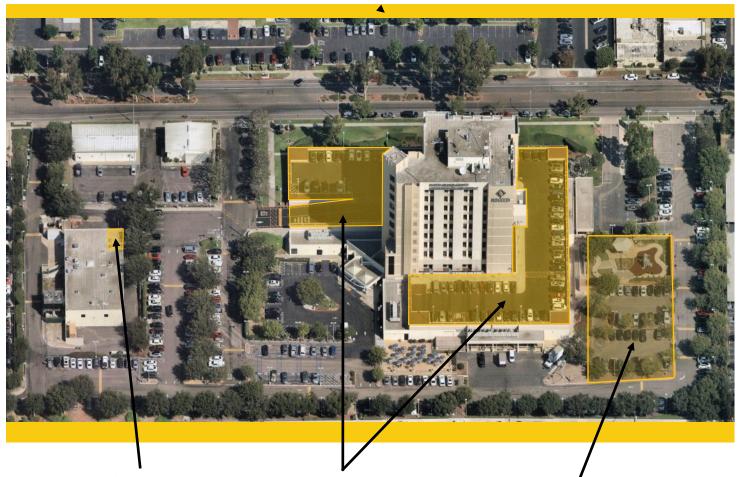

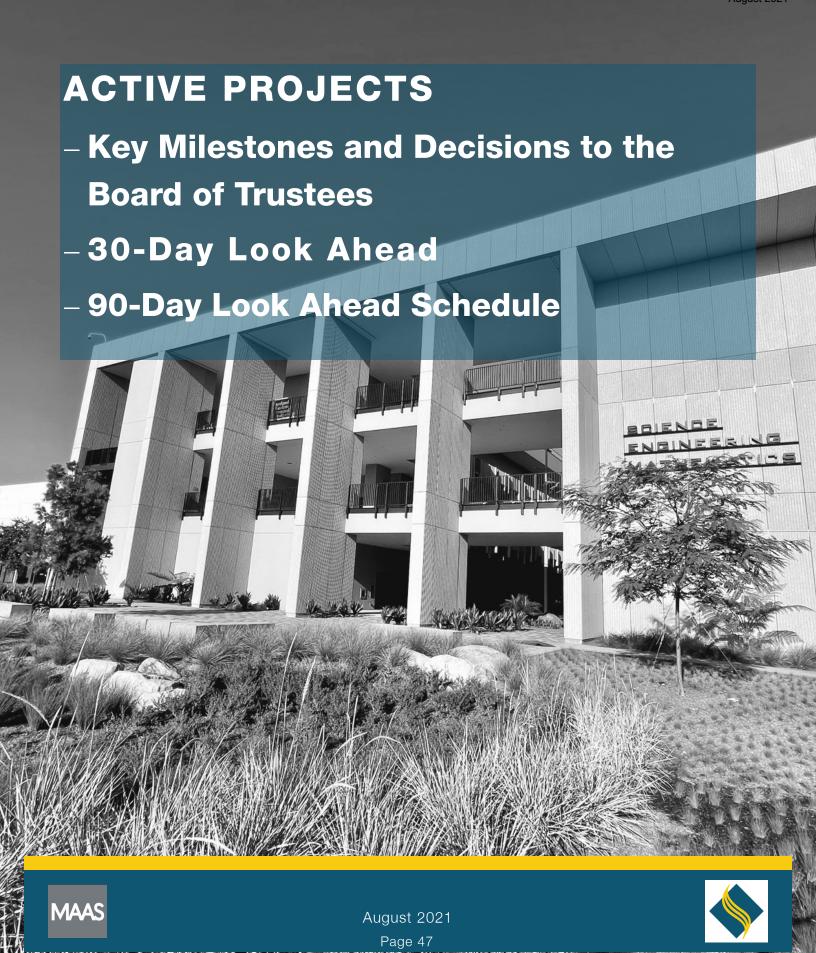

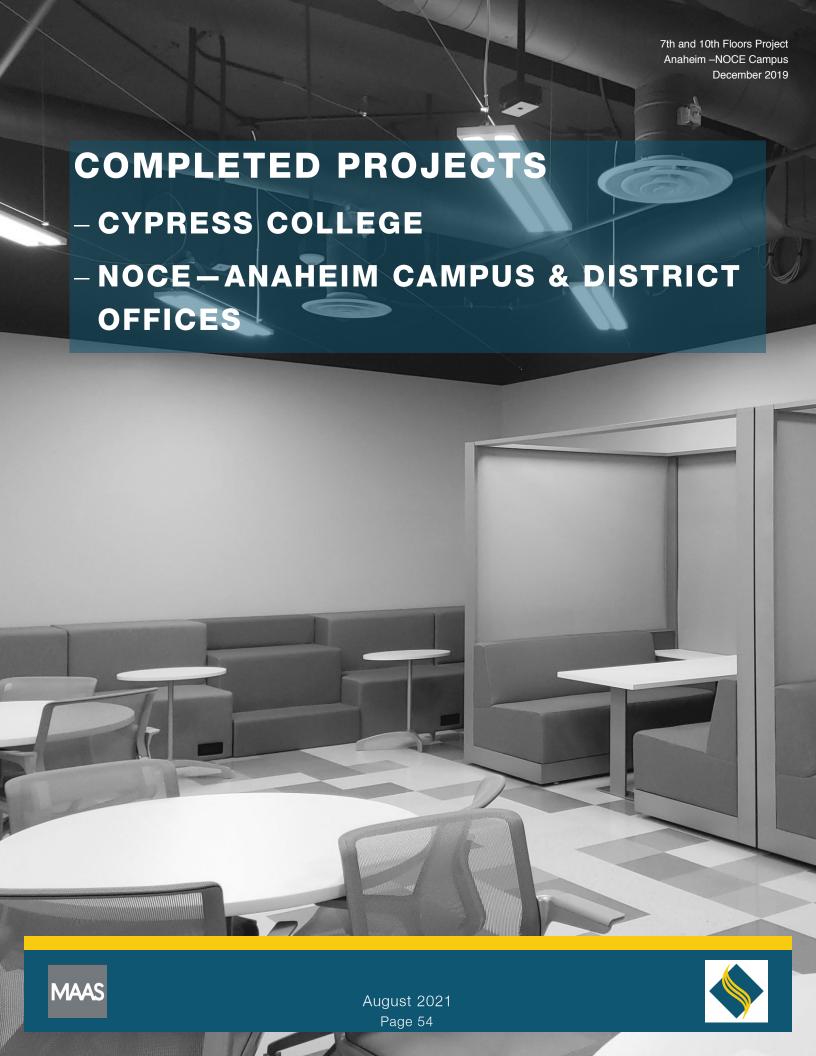
