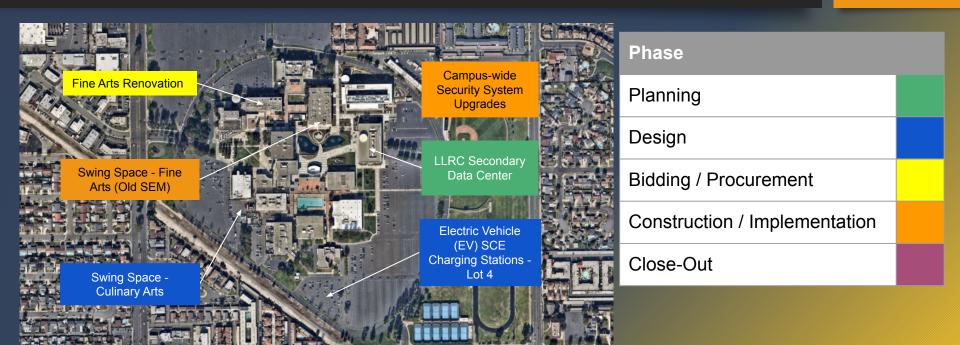

# Updates on campus projects - Cypress College

#### Fine Arts Building Renovation

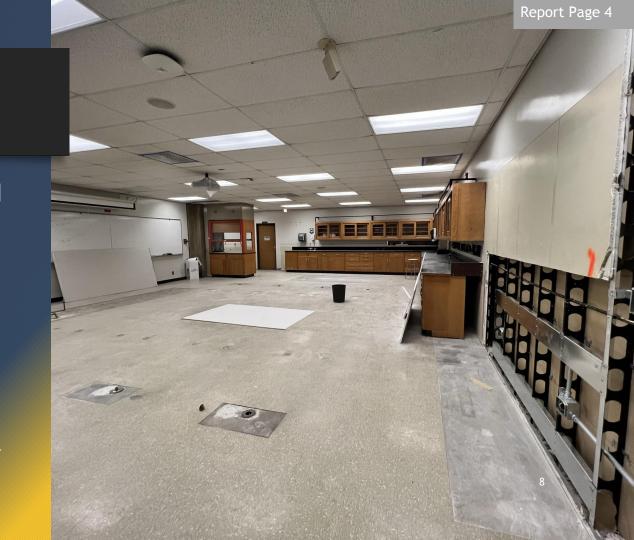
- Pre-qualification of potential trade contractors
  - 203 proposals received
  - Review is underway
- Submission of Working Drawings package in Nov 2022
- Approval to bid from CCCCO expected in Jan/Feb 2023
- Move to Swing Space at the end of Spring 2023
- Construction begins in summer 2023



# Updates on campus projects - Cypress College

## Swing Space - Fine Arts (Old SEM)

- Demolition activities are mostly complete.
- Scope of work reached 35% completion.
- Construction activities are underway with wall framing and drywall installation
- Potential Change Order to revise completion date to Jan. 2023 due to unforeseen conditions



# Updates on campus projects - Cypress College

#### Electric Vehicle (EV) SCE Charging Stations - Lot 4

- 60 charging stations inclusive of ADA-accessible stalls
- The Campus Team and SCE worked on construction documents for submission to DSA by the end of the year
- Construction start anticipated in late summer 2023



### Updates on campus projects - Cypress College

#### Campus-Wide Security Systems Upgrade

- Procurement of all components for phase 1 is now complete
- Installation of server, monitoring station, and software installation to begin in December upon delivery of a chip and cabling for the monitoring station
- Phase II will be addressed in the future as a separate project as needed

#### Swing Space - Hotel, Restaurant, and Culinary Arts

- The sole sourced contract for Mobile Kitchen has been completed and the separate piggyback contract for Global Modulars USA is underway
- Construction Documents were submitted to DSA in mid-October approval is anticipated in December
- Project plans have also been submitted to the Orange County Health Care Agency and Orange County Fire Authority for plan check

### Updates on campus projects - Cypress College

#### LLRC Secondary Data Center (Phase II)

- Additional orders for equipment were placed. The Campus anticipates a credit of \$27,000 to be applied to the cost of the second order.
- Due to backlogs in orders, their delivery may be delayed. A project extension is possible based on the delays.
- The Virtual Machine Stacks (VMS) have arrived.
- Anticipated completion is late Spring 2023
- Discussions continue over true-redundancy planning for the data center

- The project drawing and specifications are under DSA review for 6-8 mos.
- Guaranteed Maximum Price negotiations upon DSA approval expected mid-2023



## Performing Arts Complex & Demolition Buildings 1100 and 1300

- Historical Review by KSMA is complete
   Dudek completed peer review
- DSA submittal for 100 % Construction Documents occurred on November 30, 2022.
- The team incorporated finalized Division 1 language into the bid documents for general contractor



#### Wilshire Chiller Plant Relocation

- 85% Construction Documents were achieved in October
- DSA submittal for 100 % Construction Documents occurred on November 30, 2022.
- The team incorporated Division 1 language into the bid documents for the bidding process for the general contractor
- Project budget supplemented by Infrastructure project funds (Meas. J)

#### Swing Space / Interim Housing

- Project is under DSA review. Backcheck appointment with DSA is completed

   minor follow up is underway
- Anaheim Fire Department approved the fire water line in the CDs
- The forecasted delivery for the temporary modular building must be adjusted from fall 2022 to spring 2023
- RFP for IOR and LOR released to pre-qualified District Vendors
- Bidding for General Contractor in December 2023 upon DSA approval

- Westberg White responded to comments from DSA
- DSA concluded review of the submitted interior/exterior drawing and specification package
- Bid packages have been developed and assembly is underway

#### **Anaheim Campus Tower First Floor** Life/Safety Renovation

- A milestone schedule review was completed to adjust dates for bidding and construction start
- CCCCO Approval received in late October
- Coordination is underway for the initial destructive testing at precise locations
