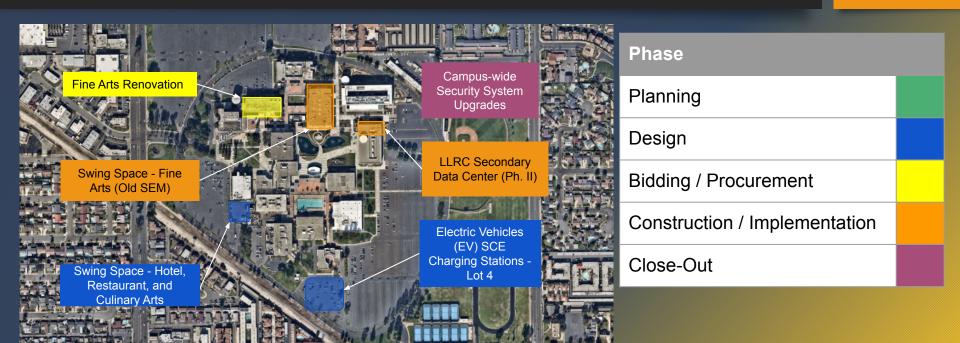

Aerial View - Cypress Campus



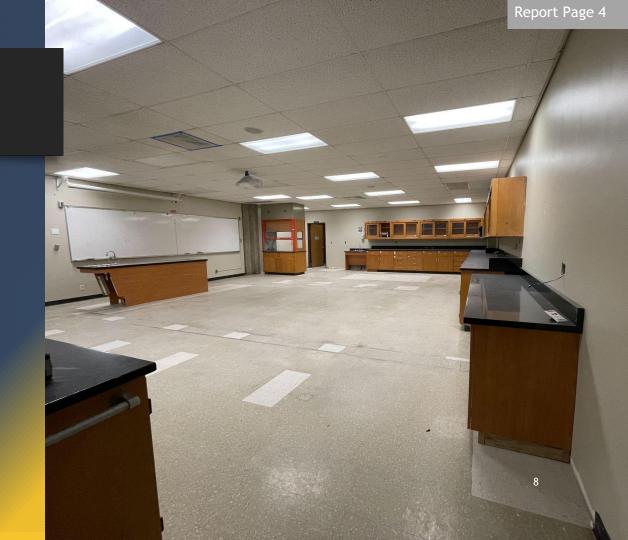
Fine Arts Building Renovation

- Pre-qualification of potential trade contractors
 - 203 proposals received
 - Review is nearing completion
- Working Drawings to CCCCO in November pending approval for bidding
- Bidding anticipated in May 2023
- Move to Swing Space at end of Spring Semester 2023



Swing Space - Fine Arts (Old SEM)

- Substantial Completion anticipated on February 28
- Punch-list activities are underway
- Change Order to revise completion date to Mar. 2023 due to unforeseen conditions and an additional \$90K approved at February 14 BOT meeting



Electric Vehicles (EV) SCE Charging Stations - Lot 4

- SCE delivered the preliminary design to the Campus Project Team in early 2023 following site walk to clarify questions on the design drawings
- Board agenda item and hearings for easement - upcoming
- DSA plan check submittal anticipated in next 20 weeks
- Construction start anticipated in late summer 2023 following DSA approval and bidding



LLRC Secondary Data Center (Phase II)

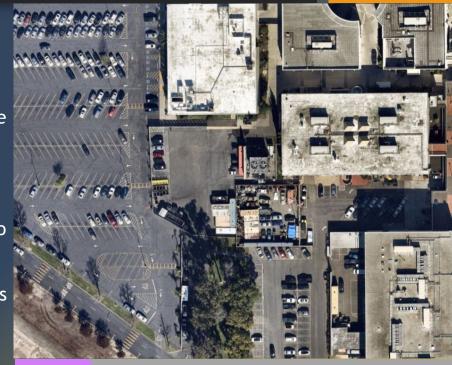
- Equipment orders have been processed. The project is nearing completion upon installation of a final component
- The Campus Project Team is assessing methods of acquiring a fiber cable feed to operate as a backup in case of outage or emergency
- Connection to ISP is planned to be incorporated in future Campus Developments
- Anticipated completion is late Spring 2023

Campus-Wide Security Systems Upgrade

- Procurement of all components for phase 1 is now complete
- Additional cabling acquired to connect a new server to the building distribution frame
- Training completed following server installation.
- Completion in February 2023. Close-out in progress
- Phase II will be addressed in the future as a separate project as needed

Swing Space - Hotel, Restaurant, and Culinary Arts

- DSA approval received for Parking Lot 1 package.
- HPI is addressing DSA back-check comments for the second package; dining and bathrooms.
- A third construction documents package will be re-submitted to DSA after Orange County Health Department approves the modular kitchen.
- Requisitions are submitted to District Purchasing to procure of mobile kitchen unit and retaining services from Global Modular.
- The budget will be augmented by \$887k local funds pending execution

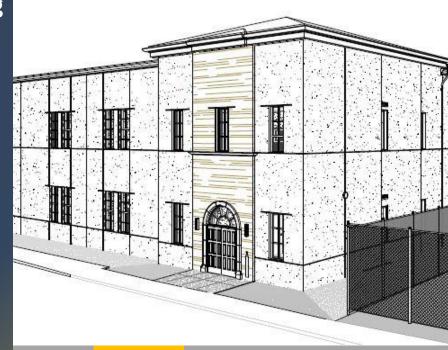
Renovate Building 300

- WWA completed all drawings and specifications and delivered the preliminary plans to CCCCO in December and CCCCO returned comments in January
- Working Drawings submitted to DSA on January 24 Plancheck review in progress
- DSA supports use of micropiles to fortify the foundation, CGS decision pending



Chapman / Newell Instructional Building and New M&O Building

- The project drawings and specifications are under review at DSA and approval is anticipated by August
- Cost reconciliation remains underway.
 The Initial Guaranteed Maximum Price (IGMP) has been received along with the probable cost estimate
- The Campus Project Team is coordinating with the City of Fullerton Public Works Agency to address the scope of work for the right-of-way improvements



New Performing Arts Complex & Demolition Buildings 1100 and 1300

- On Jan. 24, the BOT approved the EIR addendum to move forward with the proposed approach to mitigation measure no. 2. The BOT also approved adding funds to the budget.
- The November 2022 DSA submittal construction documents is anticipated to be approved in mid-2023
- Building User Group reviewed comments on the 100% CDs with the Design and Campus Project Teams



Wilshire Chiller Plant Relocation

- 100% Construction Documents (CDs) were submitted to DSA in November 2022.
- Pfeiffer addressed preliminary comments returned by DSA on the 100% CDs. Package resubmission of increment 1 of the chiller Yard occurred on February 8 to be followed at a later date for increment 2 for the arts yard relocation.
- Construction start is anticipated in October 2023.

- Final DSA approval received in January 2023
- Inspector of Record and Lab of record have been selected. Purchase orders are in progress.
- The design team met with the Building User Group to finalize furniture layout
- Bidding for selection of the General Contractor is underway - Bids Due March 10 & Mobilization Targeted for mid-April



Develop Interior and Exterior Signage

- The Campus Project Team received DSA approval for the submitted interior/exterior drawing and specification package
- Proposed cost and scope of work are being reviewed for completeness
- The Campus Project Team is finalizing pricing for the exterior signage with the KYA Group's assistance
- Preparation for bidding for interior signage is underway



Anaheim Campus Tower First Floor Life/Safety Renovation

- DSA submission of plan check occurred on January 18 with anticipated approval in June 2023
- Western Specialty Contractors performed destructive testing for hazardous materials. Analysis revealed small amounts of quartz silica that will be removed.
- Preparation for pre-qualification of general contractors



Fullerton Anaheim IT Network Refresh

Outdoor Patio Remodel

- The selection process for the Architect of Record (AOR) was underway in Dec/Jan
- The Campus Project Team entered into an agreement with PBK-WLC as the AOR
- The first design meeting took place on Feb 15 to discuss the draft design schedule and Building User Group (BUG) requirements

Updates on campus projects - IT Network Refresh

IT Network Refresh at Cypress, Fullerton, and Anaheim Campuses

- Change Order No. 4 approved by BOT in January to finalize a new completion date of June 30 and a revised scope of work
- District IS and VectorUSA are working to descope projects that cannot be completed by the new deadline
- Voice over IP (VoIP) migration anticipated to occur at Cypress Campus from February to March
- The first phase of VoIP migration is scheduled to be completed by mid March at Fullerton Campus
- Employee roaming has been completed at Anaheim and Cypress campuses

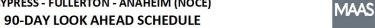
