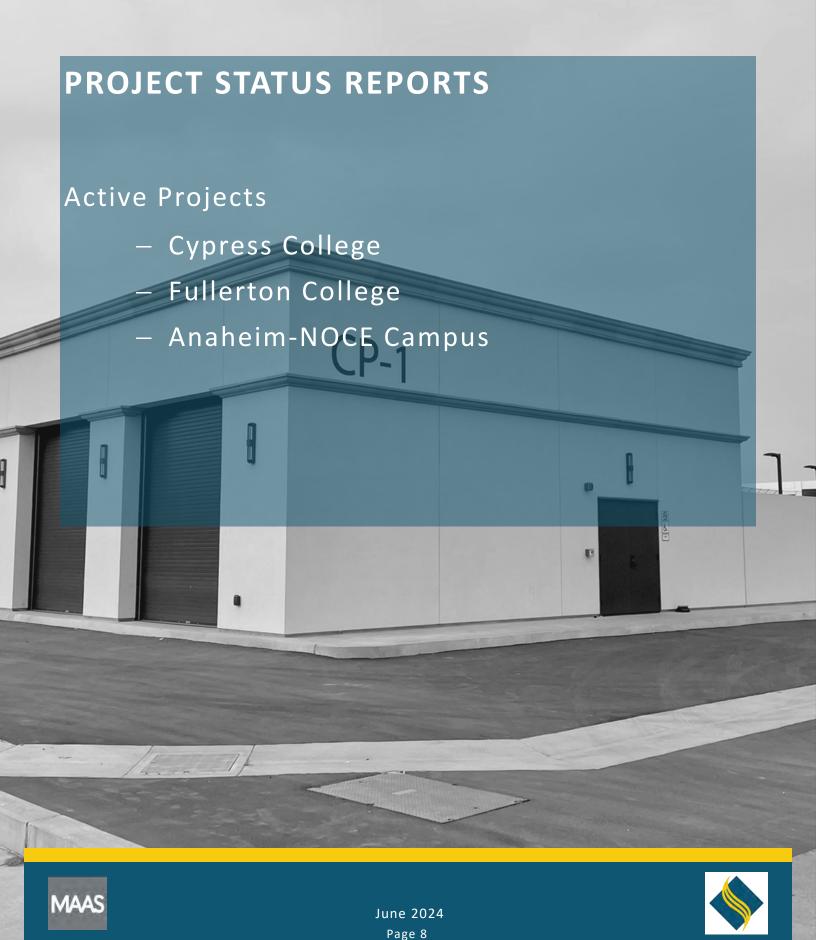

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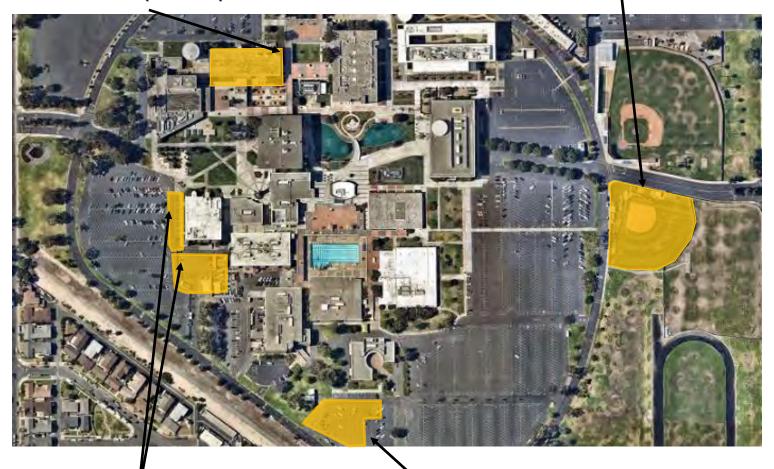

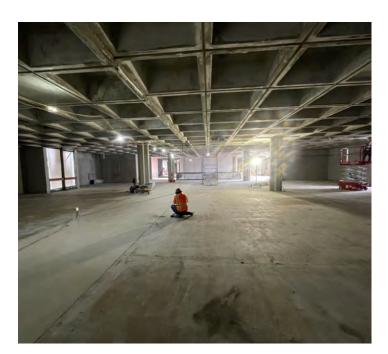

#### **Fine Arts Building Renovation**

- Crews completed demolition of the foundation walls and footings of the building. Hazardous materials abatement is underway following all State safety guidelines. Work progressed on disconnecting the building's site utilities from the complex campus utility network; the final portion on site lighting removal is being addressed.
- Crews are addressing interior building demolition inclusive of the first floor cement slab in June. Preparation for the foundation pile driving to reinforce the foundation as part of the seismic retrofit is underway. Activities will begin with the delivery of test pile materials prior to the start of installation at the end of the month. Foundation caisson drilling is anticipated to start toward the end of July.
- The Campus Project Team is working with trade contractor, Piping, Plumbing, and Construction, on the

issuance of Change Order No. 1 to address additional work required for the isolation of chilled water lines and installation valves in the vicinity of the project. A recommendation will be made to the Board of Trustees at the second meeting in June. Potential change orders associated with unforeseen construction site conditions are anticipated to be presented to the Board of Trustees in the coming months.

## Electrical Vehicles (EV) SCE Charging Stations — Lot 4

- Crews have completed fencing activities around the site perimeter followed by trenching activities that began on May 29 and concluded in the first week of June.
- Installation of the concrete vault has been





completed. A conduit pathway was constructed along the tunnels in the parking area to the location of the electrical equipment. Trenches were back-filled with slurry. Grading, wood framing, and reinforcement bar installation are in progress for upcoming concrete pours for equipment pads and pedestals in the coming weeks.

#### **Softball Field Renovations**

 The Campus Project Team is working with the geotechnical engineer and Design Team to address foundation sizing requirements based on the results of soils testing on-site. The Campus Project Team is pursuing a secondary peer review to determine next steps. Upon completion of the evaluation process, the project will enter Design Development.

#### **Renovate Building 300**

- Icon West has prepared submittals for the project including those required for the upcoming hazardous materials abatement. Simpson & Simpson held a pre-construction meeting on June 4 with all key parties to best coordinate the successful execution of the scope of work. The construction manager coordinated with the general contractor to solidify a Master Schedule that was submitted to the Campus Project Team at the end of May for review and approval.
- Additional design review services will be required for the substituted Fiber Reinforced Polymer (FRP) system solution for the project. Westberg White and the structural engineer consultant for the

project issued a service request amounting to approximately \$88K for the review and redesign of the FRP system.

#### **New Maintenance & Operations Building**

Electrical activities are underway and raceway conduits are being placed into the walls. Structural steel

installation began on May 21 for the first floor and concluded in early June.

- Work continues on Concrete Masonry Unit (CMU) wall assembly. Bricks are now in place to form the perimeter of the building. Crews have completed the fifth, sixth, and seventh lifts; work on the eighth and ninth lifts are underway. CMU activities are anticipated to conclude at the end of June. Following completion, scaffolding will be removed from the building. At the same time, roof embeds to anchor the steel to the CMU walls will be installed, alongside grouting work.
- Work on the second-floor structural steel will begin in early July with the accompaniment of a crane to support the assembly. The crane setup and pad compaction will start in early July, and roof steel





erection will occur in mid-July. A topping-off ceremony is anticipated for July 11 to commemorate the completion of the assembly of the structure of this building.

• DSA approved the deferred elevator guard-rail submittal in the second week of June. Responses to the deferred Glass Fiber Reinforced Concrete (GFRC) submittal responses by the Design Team are in progress.

#### **Chapman/Newell Instructional Building**

- The installation of roof decking is nearing completion. The general contractor team and subcontractors started establishing water and sewer connections for the building along Chapman Avenue. Activities are anticipated to conclude by the end of the month. A traffic management plan is being implemented during construction hours to fulfill the requirements of the City of Fullerton
- Crews conducted structural steel erection throughout the month of May; steel decking was completed at the end of the same month. Work on the steel stairs and additional steel work are anticipated to continue into mid-June. Exterior scaffolding assembly along the perimeter of the building will begin on June 19.

- Concrete slab edge formwork installation is in progress, alongside rebar installation for the remaining slab openings on the first floor. Reinforcement bar installation will start in late June in preparation for slab concrete pours on the second level in mid-July. Installation of exterior framing clips will begin on June 21 on the southwest corner and follow counterclockwise around the building.
- Owner Controlled Insurance Program (OCIP) representatives conducted a site walk in early June to review safety conditions at the site. Additional visits will be conducted as construction milestones are achieved.





• The GFRC deferred submittal to DSA is being addressed with responses from the design team in progress. The sheet metal dome deferred submittal was turned in to DSA on June 11 where it is under review.

#### **New Performing Arts Complex**

• The Campus Project Team received the letter from the Design Team indicating Title 24 compliance. The results indicate that the project meets State energy efficiency standards. Required signatures from the Design Team, and the Mechanical, Engineering, and Plumbing (MEP) consultant, were completed prior to the submittal of the Working Drawings to the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office for review and authorization to enter into the bidding phase. Construction is now projected to begin in January 2025. Project completion is anticipated in the first quarter of 2027.

#### Wilshire Chiller Plant Relocation

- A commissioning kick-off meeting took place on May 29 gathering together all key parties on the project to coordinate the equipment submittal process for testing upon installation prior to project turnover to the campus. Contractor mobilization completed in early June during which the trailer was set in position and crews placed site fencing around the perimeter of the site. Work is underway for the relocation of a temporary Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) path of travel to the parking stalls located in the vicinity of the project as part of Parking Lot 10. A solution will be implemented in mid-June.
- Crews initiated demolition and hazardous materials abatement following State safety

guidelines in June. Long lead submittal items such as the switchgear and panel board have been approved; the remaining long lead items are undergoing an approval process with the Architect of Record, Campus Facilities, and the building commissioning agent. The project is anticipated to be completed in May 2025.

#### **Athletic Field Improvements**

• The Campus Project Team, Campus leadership, and Westberg White reviewed preliminary options for the programming needs, adjacencies, and potential layouts. In the upcoming weeks, additional meetings will be scheduled with the Building User Group (BUG) to review these preliminary options.

#### **Develop Interior and Exterior Signage**

The Campus Project Team met with legal counsel to determine the path forward for this project as KYA Group
incorrectly determined the approximate cost of exterior signage. The Campus Project Team will deduct this
portion of the project scope of work and reissue it with the corrected anticipated cost of construction for rebidding at a later date. The Anaheim Campus letters will be corrected to match the coloration of the NOCE
signage and installed over the summer.

#### **Anaheim Tower First Floor Life/Safety Renovation**

- The installation of waterproofing is being supervised by Allana Buick and Bers for compliance with manufacturing guidelines and implementation of best practices to ensure the longevity of the installed product. In late May, an onsite meeting took place with all involved parties including the waterproofing consultant to coordinate the work in Area 3 that began on June 3 and completed on June 14.
- Asphalt and concrete demolition started in late May on Area 2 and ended in the first week of June. Crews then
  initiated concrete pouring activities starting with the topping slab and then lightweight concrete on June 7. The
  area drains have been set into their proper locations. Waterproofing will commence in the third week of June
  in Area 2.
- Crews are conducting preliminary excavations to determine the soil compositions to find the best solution for shoring the existing soil during excavation. This will allow the waterproofing work to be completed on the





retaining wall on the west side. Activities are anticipated to begin in July.

- Crews initiated demolition activities in Area 1 and the access ramp that is anticipated to conclude in mid-tolate June. Concrete pours will ensue following the anticipated conclusion of the aforementioned activities.
- On the interior, demolition for the all-gender restroom is underway; following its conclusion, crews will begin installing underground utilities. The Design Team is working to find solutions toward the connectivity of utilities such as sewer and water for the new restroom. Work is anticipated to begin on the print shop in July. The interior work is expected to conclude by mid-November.
