- 50% of concrete pile caps have been poured
- Underground utilities relocations and new building points of connections

Renovate Building 300

- The FRP submittal was prepared by Icon West, reviewed by structural engineer and sent to DSA for review on November 19.
- Cast-in-drill-hole (CIDH) installation ended in October; unforeseen condition identified and demolished.
- Micropile testing ended in late October; results favorable; production pile activities started November 6; exterior piles finished December 2; lobby piles pending.
- Pile cap activities began with excavation in November; conclusion anticipated in early 2025.
- HVAC and plumbing rough-in finished on second floor and began on the first floor.
- Interior plaster stabilization was completed; historic window restoration is in progress to be completed early December.
- Construction end anticipated in winter 2026.

New M&O Building

- Initial roofing layer was set in place.
- GFRC installation at the building entry mostly completed; Top cast shop fabrication started week of November 25th.
- Framing is ongoing at 1st and 2nd floors.
- Installing lath at exterior building.
- Drywall installation is pending the completion of roofing activities.
- Slab-on-Grade concluded in early November; interior framing almost finished on level 1; MEP started early November.
- Transformer was delivered on November 21
- Project completion anticipated in March 2025.

- Exterior sheathing and water barrier placed around building.
- Window installation and glazing done in October.
- Top cast installation is on-going.
- GFRC approved by DSA; shop fabrication is on-going with site delivery in December.
- Drywall installation and taping underway inside building.
- Ceiling grid installation underway in Area B; elevator work started in mid-November.
- Fire sprinkler work neared conclusion in November.
- Construction completion anticipated in March 2025.

Updates on campus projects - Fullerton College

New Performing Arts Complex & Demolition Buildings 1100 and 1300

- Kitchell CM drafted bid schedule and documents reviewed and approved by District and published on October 16.
- Job walk completed on October 29 and November 12 with prequalified bidders; bids due December 17; BAI anticipated in February 2025 for selected bidder.
- Construction start estimated June 2025 predicated on CCCCO approval.
- Buildings 1100 & 1300 granted 6 additional months for completion by CCCCO.



Updates on campus projects -Fullerton College

Wilshire Chiller Plant Relocation

- The Design Team completed unified utility relocation design inclusive of reroute plans for unforeseen conditions and were reviewed by PPC.
- The cost estimate provided by PPC was reviewed by OCMI and a third-party estimator. Negotiations for the cost of relocating the existing utilities followed with involved parties; the negotiated cost was presented to the Board of Trustees under Change Order No. 1 in November.
- Demolition and relocation of the unforeseen conditions began on November 18.
- Crews are addressing underground utility connection with City of Fullerton infrastructure and associated demolition.
- Construction completion targeted for August 2025.

New Welcome Center & Lot C West

- The Campus Project Team worked with Westberg White on preliminary assessments.
- A probable cost of \$64M has been determined by Westberg White.
- Construction activities anticipated in 2026 after demolition of Bldgs. 1100 and 1300.

- Campus Leadership met with Westberg White to address cost saving measures.
- The revised design criteria was reviewed by Campus Leadership.
- The initial design study was completed with input from Campus Leadership
- BUG Meeting scheduled for mid-November to address next steps of design.

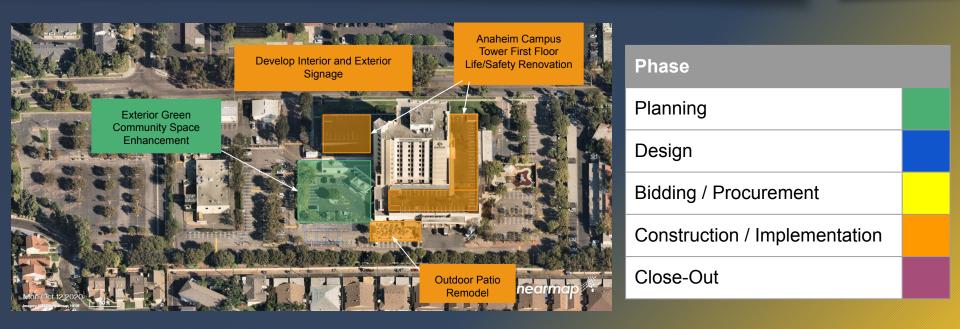

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Develop Interior and Exterior Signage

Exterior

- The AOR issued Bulletin No. 1 to address a discrepancy in color of the NOCE letters on the canopy.
- Two change orders for the marquee signage and panels for the large metal signage amounting to approximately \$73K and \$122K were reviewed by AOR.
- Marquee demolition and foundation footings anticipated in January 2025.

• The Campus Project Team met with NOCE Leadership to revisit the interior signage scope of work.



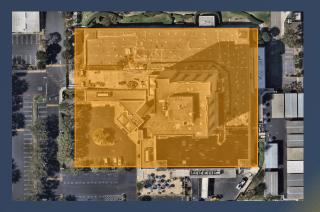
Updates on campus projects - Anaheim Campus

Anaheim Tower First Floor Life/Safety Renovation

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- Asphalt paving finished by early October. Sealant coats were applied in October and striping done in November.
- Waterproofing activities at the west elevation retaining wall finished in early November.
- Interior work on the restroom, classroom, office, and workspaces were addressed in September and finished in late October.
- Punch-List walk took place November 14 with AOR, PCL, and MAAS; remaining items include minor finishes work; substantial completion achieved December 2.
- Financial close-out began in December.
- Final completion in January 2025.

Outdoor Patio Remodel

- 9 bid proposals were received and reviewed.
- All American Building Services Inc. was approved by BOT in September.
- NTP issued for the start of construction on November 4; mobilization and site demolition are finished; excavation for foundation footings underway.
- Long-lead items being addressed; procurement is underway for Kalwall translucent panel system.
- Construction end anticipated in Summer 2025.
